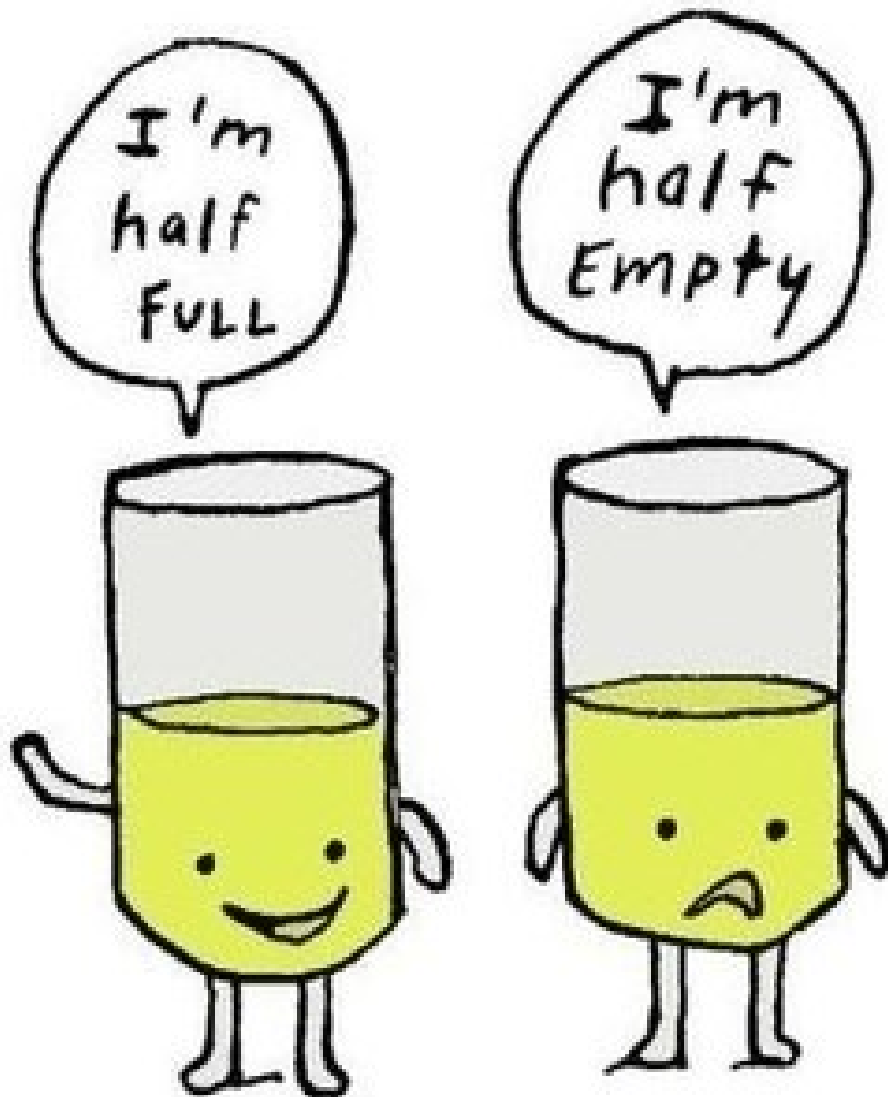


Collecting Children from School
