We have simplified the school rules and now have just three:

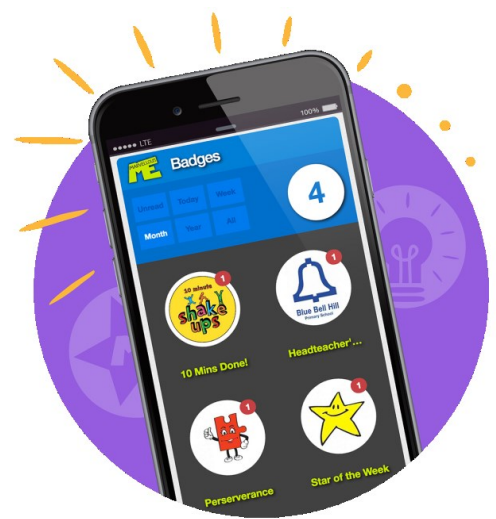
