We have a vacancy for a parent to join our Governing Board, alongside our existing parent governors, Damien Sawyer and Leanne Richards.

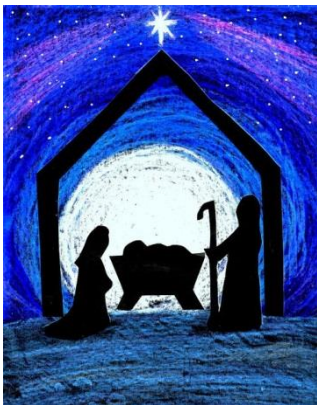


As a parent governor you will contribute to the ongoing developments and improvements in the school and steer the direction that the school and nursery are moving in.

Tickets for Nativity Performances



This year we are offering **2 tickets per family** for the nativity performances. Parents are asked to indicate which performance they would prefer to attend by **SMS**; i.e. if you want 2 tickets for the afternoon performance, send "Weds PM 2", if 2 tickets for the morning, send "Thurs AM 2" and if 1 ticket is wanted for each performance send "Weds PM 1 Thurs AM 1" to **07786 201170**.

Alternatively, you can let the school office know your request and they will record it on a list. There will be **140** tickets for each performance and the tickets will be allocated on a first come first served basis (based on time of SMS or time of addition to office list).

This is the same process as last year and is needed to address the potential risk of overcrowding which would pose a risk to safety.

We will make any **spare tickets** available at **noon on Monday 16th December** and we will inform all parents by SMS.
