## Writing task 1:

### Acrostic poem

Can you use 'Twerton Infants' to write an acrostic poem? This means that each line of the poem needs to begin with each letter.

You could even try this for your name. This is mine:

**M**aple Class are wonderful.

**I** am really missing them.

**S**uper fun,

**S**o kind and clever,

**S**ad that I'm not seeing them,

**C**reative and caring,

**O**h how amazing they are!

**T**his time is different and strange;

**T**hinking of you all.

## Writing task 2:

### Write instructions for your favourite game

What is one of your favourite games? How would you explain to someone else how to play?

Write out your instructions in full sentences.

You could start your sentences with:

First ....

Next...

After that...

### Writing task 3:

Find out and write about a habitat of your choice

Choose a habitat and find out as much as you can about it. What is in this habitat? What lives there? Where in the world is an example of this habitat? You could even make a model of the habitat to go with it.

### Writing task 4:

#### The Magic Faraway Tree

Make up a new land for the top of the tree

Write in full sentences. You could think about:

- What you can see when you reach the top of the ladder?
- What people are in this land?
- What can you do in this land?
- What can you hear and smell in this land?

You could draw a picture of your land to go with it (don't forget to give it a title).

### Writing task 5:

Write a letter to somebody in your family and put it somewhere in the house where they will find it and be surprised!

### Writing task 6:

Find out and write about an animal of your choice

Choose an animal and find out as much as you can about it. Where does it live? What does it eat? What does it look like?

You could even draw/paint/make a model of your chosen animal.

### Writing task 7:

If you could have any pet, real or pretend, what would it be?

Write in full sentences. You could think about:

- What would your pet look like?
- What would your pet eat?
- What would your pet sleep in?
- What is your pet's name?



## Writing task 8:

If you could design your own school what would it be like?

Write in full sentences. You could think about:

- What lessons would be taught? E.g. trampolining lessons, chocolate making lessons!
- What would it look like? E.g. a circle shape with a huge playground in the middle, a giant forest outside.
- Who would the teachers be? Maybe your favourite cartoon characters...
- What would be on the dinner menu?

You could draw a picture to go with it.

## Writing task 9:

If you could go anywhere, where would you go and why?

Think about-

- Where is the place? E.g. the North Pole.
- What would you do there? E.g. I would go fishing and see a polar bear.
- Why do you want to go?

## Writing task 10:

Write a shopping list for the supermarket

If you were allowed to do the food shop for your family this week, what would you buy? Write your shopping list.

## Writing task 11:

Alphabet challenge

Can you write a food item for every letter of the alphabet?

## Writing task 12:

Can you write a note for each member of your family, telling them something you like about them? Maybe put their note on their pillow so they find it when they go to bed.



## Writing task 13:

### Colour Poem

Write a colour poem by choosing colours and writing something of that colour for each. Remember to use lots of adjectives (descriptive words)

Here is mine:

Red like a loud, fast fire engine.

Green like a croaking, ugly toad.

Blue like a cool, refreshing swimming pool.

Yellow like a fluffy, cute duckling.

Purple like a long, magical wizards cloak.

## Writing task 14:

Pick your favourite book character and describe them.

You might pick one of these characters- the Gingerbread Man, Little Red Riding Hood, the Gruffalo, Stick Man, the Big Bad Wolf, the Little Red Hen.

Think about-

- What they look like
- What sort of person are they? E.g. bossy, mean, funny, kind.
- What do they like doing? E.g. eating people up!

## Writing task 15 (can be done over a few days):

Write your own story: Make your own book

What characters will be in it? Where will the story be set? What adventure will happen? How will it end?
