Remote Learning Survey - £20 prize


We are now 5 weeks in to this term and the current Lockdown arrangements for learning both in school and at home.

Nursery closed until Monday 22nd February

Yesterday, during regular routine testing that our staff voluntarily take part in, a member of the nursery team tested positive for coronavirus.

Initially this was with one of the instant Lateral Flow Device (LFD) tests devices that schools staff use at home, similar to the tests that secondary schools pupils are now using. Following the positive LFD test result, the member of staff then booked a PCR test at a testing centre yesterday evening and the result came through this morning, confirming coronavirus.

Consequently, 19 nursery-aged children and 4 other members of staff are now required to isolate for 10 days. This means that we are unable to staff the nursery and it will remain closed for the rest of this week.

We understand that this will be disappointing news to many children and parents and we are sorry for the disruption.

Our best wishes for good health go to all our nursery staff and children and we hope the isolation period is kind to you all.
