Service Update from First Bus:

Poolemead Road (part) in Twerton, Bath will be closed to services 5 from 07:00 on Monday 30th January and will remain fully closed until 19:00 on Friday 10th February (including weekend).

Service 5 will operate normal route as far as the Wedgewood Road bus stop then divert to resume normal route at the junction of Shaws Way and Newton Road.

Regretfully the bus stops Linley Close, Pennard Green and Cameley Green will not be served.

Passengers are advised to use either Wedgewood Road or Redland Park bus stops.
